

VERMONT STATE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (VSTRS)

The Vermont State Teachers' Retirement System (VSTRS) is the public pension plan provided by the State of Vermont for State teachers. It was created in 1947 and is governed by [Vermont Statute Title 16, Chapter 55](#). The membership as of June 30, 2020 is:

- 9,996 active
- 2,710 inactive
- 887 terminated vested
- 9,843 retired
